USING YOUR FARMERS MARKET CHECKS

- Checks can only be used at approved CERTIFIED farmers markets. Look for the "California Certified Farmers Market" sign.
- Buy only FRESH fruits, vegetables, and edible herbs with your checks.
- You cannot buy jam, honey, nuts, eggs, flowers or baked goods with your checks.
- Each check is worth \$10.00. Checks cannot be exchanged for cash. Farmers cannot give change. If you buy less than \$10.00, the farmer will add more fruits and vegetables of your choice to make up the difference.
- Farmers may accept cash or food stamps to cover the purchase beyond the amount of the check.
- Handle your checks as if they were cash. Lost or stolen checks will not be replaced.
- Damaged checks or checks without the serial numbers, will not be accepted.
- Checks may not be redeemed at a grocery store.
- If you feel that you have been treated unfairly, contact the farmers market manager or your WIC staff.
- Use your checks between May 1, 2022 and November 30, 2022.
